2009 Rule Changes for RC Racing

ROAR has made some significant changes for 2009. Some of the changes include:

Super Stock only including 13.5 Brushless motors.

Stock is still 27T brushed, but is now 17.5 Brushless.

10.5 is now considered a mod motor.

As we move closer to the racing season, be sure to come out to the track, as those who help with the track rebuilds will be deciding what classes we run next year.
