2010 WWWC Ice Melter Mini-z Race

This year, we had 20 drivers and 52 entries for our 5 race classes. We had drivers from Salt Lake City Utah, Pueblo Colorado, Taylorsville Utah, Spring Ville Utah, Colorado Springs Colorado, South Jordan Utah, West Jordan Utah, and Riverton Wyoming. Our biggest class was Stock, where we had 20 drivers. We had 12 vehicles in our Pan Car class, 6 drivers in Nascar, 6 drivers in Stock Kyosho, and 9 Formula 1 drivers. If one driver signed up for 3 classes, they drove for 126 minutes total this weekend. That is a long time to focus on a 1:28th scale car moving at scale speeds of hundreds of miles an hour.

We started at 11 a.m. on Saturday and ran 3 qualifying races. Sunday, we held one more qualifier at 10 a.m., then started the Main races. The drivers stood on the stage as a driver's stand, there were tables and chairs around the edges of the room for pit stalls, and seating for spectators. We had great fun, met new friends, and made plans to do this again next year.
